## 2023 Cabernet Sauvignon PASO ROBLES

### The Wine

Bold yet approachable, the 2023 Vina Robles Cabernet Sauvignon is crafted to showcase the depth, richness, and structure for which Paso Robles is renowned. Aged in a mix of French, Hungarian, and American oak, this wine balances concentrated dark fruit with savory spice and polished tannins—making it both cellar-worthy and ready to enjoy in its youth.

### Varietal Composition

87% Cabernet Sauvignon, 11% Petit Verdot, 1% Cabernet Franc, 1% Malbec

### Vintage Notes

The 2023 growing season in Paso Robles delivered near-ideal conditions for Cabernet Sauvignon. A cool spring delayed budbreak slightly, allowing for a long and even ripening period. Warm but not excessive summer temperatures encouraged full phenolic development and rich flavor concentration, while cooler evenings helped retain acidity and structure. The result: a balanced and expressive vintage with excellent aging potential.

### Vineyard Notes

This Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from a range of Vina Robles estate vineyards across five Paso Robles districts—Creston Valley, El Pomar, Estrella, Geneseo, and Adelaida. Each district contributes a unique element to the final blend, resulting in a layered, site-driven expression of Paso Robles Cabernet.

### Winemaking

Fruit was hand-harvested in the early morning to preserve freshness, then carefully sorted, destemmed, and optically berry sorted at the winery. Fermentation took place in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks with regular pump-overs to build color, body, and tannin structure. Following primary fermentation, the wine was aged in French, Hungarian, and American oak barrels, for 18 months to ensure harmony and complexity in the final blend.

### Tasting Notes

The 2023 Cabernet Sauvignon opens with expressive aromas of black cherry, ripe blackberry, and plum, accented by cedar, vanilla bean, and a hint of baking spice from oak aging. On the palate, the wine is full-bodied and structured, delivering layers of dark fruit, mocha, and dried herbs, wrapped in firm yet polished tannins. A lingering finish of toasted oak and spice rounds out this classic Paso Robles Cabernet.
