## 2020 BRUT ROSÉ RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY

### THE WINE

Fresh, bright, and complex, this sparkling rosé showcases a brilliant coral hue and refined mousse. Bursting with red fruit, citrus, and spice, it strikes a perfect balance of elegance and energy. From its wild, aromatic nose to its creamy, lingering finish, this wine is built to both celebrate and savor.

Russian River Valley

### VINEYARD NOTES

Pinot Noir - Sourced from the Martin Ray Estate Vineyard on the Laguna Ridge—defined by Goldridge soils, fog-laden mornings, and cool Pacific breezes.

Chardonnay - From the acclaimed Dutton Ranch Mill Station Vineyard, contributing vibrancy and structure to the blend.

### VARIETAL COMPOSITION

78% Pinot Noir  
22% Chardonnay

### VINTAGE NOTES

A mild growing season with cool nights and moderate temperatures allowed for slow, even ripening. Fruit for this sparkling wine was picked early to preserve acidity and delicacy, laying the foundation for extended aging and precision.

### WINEMAKING NOTES

Crafted in the traditional method, all fruit was hand-harvested and fermented in temperature-controlled stainless steel to maintain freshness. The final blend was bottled for secondary fermentation and aged en tirage for four years to develop depth and a fine, persistent mousse.

- Dosage: 4.5 g/L (Ultra Brut)
- Tirage Bottled: April 28, 2021
- Disgorged: February 3–5, 2025

### TASTING NOTES

Elegant and expressive with aromas and flavors of wild strawberries, white raspberry, melon, cherry-lime, lilac and orange-creamsicle. Notes of ginger, ocean spray, and saline add lift, while the extended aging provides creamy texture and a delicate, persistent mousse.
