## 2023 Mountain Road Reserve ADELAIDA DISTRICT, PASO ROBLES

### The Wine

Rich, structured, and beautifully composed, the 2023 Mountain Road Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon represents a refined yet powerful expression of Paso Robles. Crafted from select small lots, this wine balances depth, elegance, and age-worthy structure.

### Varietal Composition

80% Cabernet Sauvignon  
8% Cabernet Franc  
7% Petit Verdot  
5% Malbec

### Vintage Notes

The 2023 growing season in Paso Robles provided a long, even ripening period with warm days and cool nights. These conditions allowed Cabernet Sauvignon to develop exceptional concentration and complexity while retaining freshness and balance, ideal for reserve-level wines.

### Vineyard Notes

Sourced from Bear Valley and White Cliffs Vineyards in the Adelaida District, where rugged coastal terrain meets strong marine influence. At elevations around 1,700 feet and just 12 miles from the Pacific Ocean, these sites feature rocky calcareous soils and southwestern exposures that produce fruit with remarkable intensity, structure, and depth.

### Winemaking

This limited-production wine is crafted from small, select lots of Cabernet Sauvignon, with a touch of Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, and Malbec to enhance structure and complexity. Following fermentation, the wine was aged for 20 months in French oak barrels, developing a rich texture and integrated oak profile.

### Tasting Notes

The 2023 Mountain Road Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon is refined yet expressive, opening with aromas of black and red fruit layered with creamy oak notes. The palate is rich and structured, with a seamless texture and balanced depth. Bright acidity carries through the wine, leading to a long, polished finish that highlights both elegance and power.
