2024 LIGHT PINOT NOIR Sonoma County

Style

Juicy, vibrant, and unapologetically Pinot Noir. Crafted in a lighter style without compromising character, this wine delivers bright fruit, silky texture, and effortless drinkability with every glass.

Vineyards

Sourced primarily from the Russian River Valley, with additional vineyard sites in Green Valley and Sonoma Carneros, this Pinot Noir reflects Sonoma County's coolest growing regions. Coastal fog, warm afternoons, and diverse soils produce fruit with vibrant acidity, expressive aromatics, and exceptional balance.

Composition

100% Sonoma County

Winemaking

- Crafted as a traditional Sonoma County Pinot Noir
- Fully fermented to develop natural varietal character and complexity
- After fermentation, a portion of the wine goes through a gentle de-alcoholization process
- The de-alcoholized wine is blended back with the base wine to achieve a final 9% ABV target
- Preserves the wine's natural aromatics, texture, and balance
- Aged in 30% new French oak

Tasting Notes

Expressive aromas of strawberry rhubarb pie and Bing cherry mingle with hints of rose syrup, brown sugar, and root beer spice. Juicy layers of red fruit and a lively, crunchy texture carry through to a fresh, balanced finish that's vibrant, silky, and unmistakably Pinot Noir.
